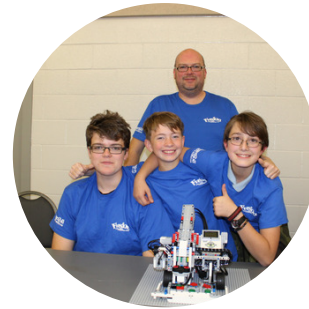


2019-2020 Grant Applications Now Open



Spring applications now accepted until April 26, 2019.



What we fund:

Community Futures Oxford administers grants from two funds: Community Economic Development (CED) Initiative and the Future Oxford Legacy Fund.

The **CED Initiative** provides seed funding to projects that generate economic benefits in several priority areas including workforce development, agriculture/rural sector, business development, social infrastructure, youth programs, capacity development, tourism development and cultural/environmental stewardship.

The **Future Oxford Legacy Fund** provides funding for projects that aim to create a vibrant community. Projects must advance at least one of the three sustainability pillars by contributing to the actions detailed within the Future Oxford Community Sustainability Plan.

Who can apply:

Eligible applicants must operate within/serve Oxford County and be one of the following:

- registered charity or not-for-profit organization
- municipality
- community organization or association
- social service institution

How to Apply:

Application forms can be found and submitted under the funding tab of the Community Futures Oxford website or by clicking [here](#). If a project is eligible for both funds, one application is to be submitted and can apply simultaneously.

When to Apply:

SPRING DEADLINE: Applications due **April 26, 2019** with funding to be disbursed to successful applicants by May 31, 2019 .

FALL DEADLINE: Applications due **October 25, 2019** with funding disbursed to successful applications by November 29, 2019.

Please note that funding is disbursed as it receives approval from our Board of Directors and funding is not guaranteed to be available beyond the spring deadline.
